A contract renewal after 12 months as well as an increase of working hours is intended but depends on the availability of funds.

The MendaHouse Initative:

MendaHouse is an initiative that promotes economic development and social cohesion in Mendankwe/Bamenda. To achieve this objective, MendaHouse 1) offers educational counselling to school children and their families, and 2) provides study resources and premises for self-study and training courses. After the renovation of a suitable building at the center of Mendankwe, the opening of a library is a first key milestone to reach the goals of MendaHouse.

- Planning the opening of the library incl. preparing procurement and budget plans, procuring, registering and cataloguing of books, financial and impact reporting.
- Managing the library incl. registration of child readers, handing out of books, advising and supervising child readers whilst books are being used.
- Developing a pedagogical concept for mentoring and assisting child readers.
- Developing and implementing a concept for recruiting volunteers for tutoring and for mentoring.
